BOXING INVITATIONAL**

**1. REFERENCES:**

- a. AR 215-1, 24 Sep 10, Non-appropriated Fund Instrumentalities and Morale, Welfare and Recreation Activities.
- b. Army in Europe (AE) Regulation 215-1-8, 6 Jul 12, Conducting Europe Region Sports & League Championships.
- c. Current USA Boxing Official Rules.

**2. WHAT:**

United States Army Garrison Bavaria Boxing Clinic and Invitational Event.

**3. WHEN:**

Boxing Event – 17 March 2018, 1900 hours.

**4. WHERE:**

Memorial Fitness Center, Rose Barracks, Bldg. 616  
USAG Bavaria

**5. ENTRIES:**

Garrisons/Bases are authorized an unlimited number of entries.

**6. REGISTRATION:**

Pre-registration is required, Individuals and Teams must pre-register NLT 2 March 2018 by emailing the registration form to [usarmy.grafenwoehr.imcom-fmwrc.list.sports-and-fitness@mail.mil](mailto:usarmy.grafenwoehr.imcom-fmwrc.list.sports-and-fitness@mail.mil)

**7. CANCELLATION**

A minimum of 20 participants is required for the event to be conducted. If 20 are not pre-registered prior to 2 March 2018 the event will be cancelled.

**8. ELIGIBILITY:**

- a. This competition is open to US Active Duty/Active Reserve Military members.
- b. Each military member must be assigned or attached on official orders to the Base/Garrison/Unit they represent.

**9. CATAGORIES:**

- a. Competition will be limited to NOVICE and OPEN Boxers, based upon individual boxing records and weight divisions.
- b. Competition is open to both Male and Female Boxers.

**10. COACHES/  
BOXER MEETING**

All Coaches/Boxers must be present for the mandatory safety briefing on Sat, 17 March 2018, @ 1700 hours at MFC, 616, Rose Barracks, USAG Bavaria

11. **PHYSICALS/WEIGH-INS:**

a. Medical physicals and Weigh-ins will be conducted Sat, 17 March 2018, MFC, Bldg. 616, 0900-1200 day of the competition. Weigh-ins and medical exams are mandatory, and IAW with USA Boxing and USAREUR Reg. 215-1; they must be completed on site. Failure to complete weigh-ins and physicals will result in **NO COMPETITION!!!**

12. **WEIGHT CLASSES:**

a. FEMALE (Weight Classes): 106lbs, 112lbs, 119lbs, 125lbs, 132lbs, 141lbs, 152lbs, 165lbs, 178lbs, 178+lbs.

b. MALE (Weight Classes): 108lbs, 114lbs, 123lbs, 132lbs, 141lbs, 152lbs, 165lbs, 178lbs, 201lbs, 201+lbs.

13. **FORMAT:**

a. Format:

**NOVICE** – Female and Male Novice boxers will box three (3) – 90 seconds rounds with a one minute rest period between rounds.

**OPEN** - Female Open boxers and Male Open Boxers will box three (3) – 2 minute rounds and with a one (1) minute rest period between rounds.

b. Quotas will NOT be set on the number of entrants a Base/Garrison/Unit may submit; however, the final selection of who will be competing lies solely on the discretion of the Tournament Director(s) and the Rules of USA Boxing.

c. Pairing requirements /factors:

(1) Age (Boxers 35 years and older are entered into the Masters Division).

(2) Record (11 bouts and greater, Boxer is considered to be Open, 10 bouts and less, Boxer is considered to be Novice). Boxers will be paired accordingly.

14. **OPENING CEREMONY:**

Sat, 17 March 2018, 1845 hours, MFC, Bldg. 616. All boxers/coaches are required to participate in Opening Ceremonies.

15. **AWARDS:**

a. First and second place individual awards for each bout. (Individual awards will be presented upon the conclusion of each bout on Sat, 17 March 2018.

b. First, second and third place team awards. (Team will be presented at conclusion of the event).

c. Best Overall Male & Female Boxer (Best overall award will be presented at conclusion of the event).

- 16. EQUIPMENT:** The host site will provide equipment; gloves, groin protectors, breast protectors, head gear and hand wraps; however, participants are responsible for their form fitted mouth piece. **RUBBER MOUTHPIECES WILL NOT BE AUTHORIZED.**
- 17. TRANSPORTATION:** It is the responsibility of each respective community of participants to provide transportation to and from this event.
- 18. BILLETING:** **FREE** Open Bay Troop Billeting is available for competitors only! Participants wishing to use this service must bring their own sleeping mats, sleeping bags, etc. This free service is on a first come, first serve basis.

# **RULES OF COMPETITION**

1. **Registration/Weigh-Ins/Physicals:** on the day of the competition, weigh-ins, physical and administrative registration will be conducted from 0900 - 1200 hours. Boxers who fail to complete the weigh-ins and physicals will not be allowed to compete.
2. **Duration of Round:** **NOVICE** – Female and Male Novice boxers will box three (3) – 90 seconds rounds with a one minute rest period between rounds.  
  
**OPEN** - Female Open boxers and Male Open Boxers will box three (3) – 2 minute rounds and with a one (1) minute rest period between rounds.
3. **Glove Size:** Each competitor will compete with gloves weights as specified in USA Boxing rule book; twelve ounces (12 oz).
4. **Mouthpiece:** It is mandatory for each competitor to have a Form Fitted Mouthpiece. Rubber mouthpieces are not authorized.
5. **Coaches:** Each competitor will be allowed to have two coaches in their respective corner.
6. **Officials:** The USAG Bavaria Sports Office will select qualified Referees/Judges who will officials for this competition.
