PAYMENT POLICIES

The Leisure Travel trips for Grafenwoehr will be facilitated through a contracted company. Because of this change, Euro costs (per person) for these trips are listed. Customers still have the option to pay for these trips in dollars or credit card. The dollar cost per trip is contingent on the monthly Euro/Dollar exchange rate designated by the Defense Finance and Accounting (DFAS) Office. Customers desiring to pay in dollars or credit card can do so. Prior to determining the actual cost in dollars, the published euro cost for the trip must be divided by the established rate set by DFAS. Please keep in mind that the DFAS Euro/Dollar rate will differ from the local bank rate.

REFUND POLICY

- Original receipt is required when asking for refunds.
- No refund for no show.

DAY TRIP REFUND POLICY

- Cancellation up to three working days prior to trip: 100% refund.
- Cancellation two working days prior to trip: 50% refund.
- Cancellation one working day prior to or day of trip: No refund.

OVERNIGHT REFUND POLICY

- A (non-refundable) deposit of \$100 per child and \$150 per adult is required upon registration.
- 30 days prior to the trip's departure date: A minimum of 50% of the trip cost is required. At this time the deposit is not refundable due to contractual obligations with hotels and other agencies.
- 14 days prior to the trip's departure date: The remaining balance of the trip cost is required.
- Cancellation up to 31 days OR per the contractor established deadline prior to a trip's departure date: A full refund will be issued unless otherwise indicated.
- Cancellation within 30 days of the trip's departure date: The amount refunded depends on the specific hotel's cancellation policy. The administration fee of \$150 deposit per adult will not be refunded, unless the cancellation reason is supported by documentation that is signed by a commanding officer or physician. Customers will only receive refunds if their balance paid exceeds the obligation to our contractors. Only the fees paid exceeding our costs will be refunded.
- Soldiers must have leave forms approved prior to the 30 day cancellation date.
- If ODR staff cancels the trip, all customers providing their original registration receipt will receive a full refund.
- ODR reserves the right to forfeit any reservation that does not pay the balances due at the specified times prior to the trip's departure date as stated above.

PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

Travel passports are required for all trips leaving Germany; however, for customers in possession of a passport other than U.S. or European, special considerations must be observed. It is the responsibility of the individual customer to ensure they have all appropriate Visas necessary for entry to countries traveled by Leisure Travel Services during the trip. For a listing of travel advisories, please consult the country of destination for restrictions.

TWO CASTLES

April 29 | May 27 | June 24 | July 29 | August 26 | September 30

Germany is famous for its castles, and Bavaria offers the biggest and best of them all. A building frenzy was initiated by King Ludwig II during his short reign, and while he almost bankrupted the country, the castles are a lasting testimony to fairy tales. Tour the world famous Neuschwanstein and the more sedate Hohenschwangau, both located in Schwangau. Entry will be approximately 15€ per person per castle. Price: 48€/adult, 38€/child ages 3-12, 12€/child under 3

BERLIN

April 14 | May 12 | June 9 | July 14 | August 11 | September 8

Berlin's 800 year history seems short compared to other European cities, but the city offers just as much. Berlin has weathered through turmoil and prosperity, both leaving their mark. Embarck on a three-hour bus tour of some major sites including the Brandenburg Gate, the Berlin Wall memorial site, Checkpoint Charlie and much more. There will be free time to explore afterwards. BLACK FOREST

April 28 | June 23 | August 25

Black Forest, where many of the cuckoo clocks are hand carved, is a very unique region in Germany. Visit the city of Triberg to see the largest waterfall in Germany, tour the museum or shop for the cuckoo or grandfather clock of your choice. Roaming around the beautiful countryside is also an encouraged activity. Remember to bring a VAT form. Price: 59€/adult, 49€/child ages 3-12, 12€/child under 3

DACHAU & MUNICH NATIONAL MUSEUM

April 15 | May 13 | September 9

Tour the historic Dachau Concentration Camp memorial site. The main camp was comprised of the actual prisoners' camp, the SS area as well as various subsidiary camps, such as the so-called plantation, the shooting range at Hebertshausen and the burial grounds for concentration camp prisoners, now the Concentration Camp Memorial Cemetery Dachau-Leitenberg. After visiting Dachau, travel to the Munich National Museum, the largest technological museum in the world. It offers a hands-on exploration of German science and technology. The German science museum price for an adult is approximately 8,50€ and 4€ for children ages 6 and up. Price: 36€/adult, 28€/ child ages 3-12, 12€/child under 3

DRESDEN

May 26 | July 28

Go sightseeing in this world famous Sachsen City! Check out the museums in the Zwinger, Frauenkirche, Old Master's picture gallery, Old and New Green Vault treasuries, Porcelain museum or the Residenz Schloss. Tours are also available with the Dresden hop-on and hopoff bus tour, or a walking tour of the historical city center that starts at the Dresden tourist information center. There are also many shopping opportunities throughout the city as well. Price: 49€/adult, 39€/child ages 3-12, 12€/child under 3

EAGLE'S NEST AND SALT MINES

June 30 | July 22 | August 12

The Eagle's Nest, Hitler's famous retreat, is a lovely chateau located at the crest of a mountain in the Bavarian Alps. The tour bus parks at the base of the mountain, so customers must choose whether to hike to the crest or to take the local bus, which costs around 24,50€ per person. After departing the Eagle's Nest, visit the salt mines located on the Austrian border. Tourists will be issued traditional salt worker uniforms and taken into the tunnels. The cost of the salt mines tour is an additional 17€ per adult and 10€ per child. All entry fees are not included and are approximations. Price: 48€/adult, 38€/child ages 3-12, 15€/child under 3

EUROPA-PARK AMUSEMENT PARK

June 30 | July 21 | August 4

This theme park is broken down into the European countries with an Adventure Land and Water Park section. The rides in each region stay true to the culture of that country. For roller coaster fans: Europa-Park is for you! Entry tickets are not included. Price: 58€/adult, 48€/child ages 3-12, 12€/child under 3

HOLIDAY PARK

May 5 | July 8 | September 23

Holiday Park offers a variety of rides and attractions, including a children's area and shows. Rides include the Expedition G-force, Free Fall Tower and the water ride Donnerfluss. Located near Mannheim, the park is a great destination for families as well as single soldiers. Entry tickets not included. Price: 40€/adult, 30€/child ages 3-12, 12€/child under 3

Boleslaweic, Poland is the heart of the pottery industry. The factories continue to hand stamp the patterns on each piece in the hundred-year-old tradition. Designs range from original ones inspired by the peacock to more modern patterns. The pottery is made from white clay and many pieces are microwave and dishwasher-safe. Visit a variety of stores that to start or complete a collection. Not recommended for children. Price: 59€/adult, 49€/child ages 3-12, 15€/child under 3

April 8 | May 6 | June 3 | July 1 | August 5 | September 2 | October 7



This is a highly adventurous trip and not one to be missed. Participants must be in good physical shape and 16 years or older with parent in attendance. Transportation, guide service, climbing gear, camping gear, reservation for a night in a mountain hut (food can be purchased at the hut for an additional cost) and lift tickets included. Price: \$249/person

DANUBE BIKE TOUR: PASSAU TO VIENNA*

August 31 - September 3 (Sign up by August 14)

Traverse the "Donau Radweg" (Danube Bike Trail) in September with us! The Donau Radweg is a beautiful paved biking trail which crosses very diverse terrain. OETZTAL ADVENTURE WEEKEND*

May 25-28

Join us for a whitewater rafting, canyoning and klettersteig adventure in the beautiful Tirol Region of Austria! The klettersteig climb up to the largest waterfall in Tirol culminates on a suspended cable bridge above the roaring waterfall. (Be prepared to get a little wet!) Conquer a four-hour river experience on the Imster Schlucht, considered a class III with its large waves and rapids, but also has calm areas where swimming is encouraged. This river run guarantees fun for new and experienced rafters alike. Spend up to four hours climbing, swimming, sliding and jumping through the Tirolian canyons with an experienced guide. The adventure continues with rafting the Oetztaler Ache - not for the faint-hearted! This 13-kilometer section of river is one of the most extreme whitewater sections in Europe. Participants must be at least 14 years of age, in good shape, be able to swim and not afraid of heights. Transportation, equipment, klettersteig and lodging with halfboard included. Standup paddle boarding is a great way to score some cool points while working on balance and paddling. Come spend the evening paddling beautiful Dickhauter Lake, mastering your skills or practicing your yoga. Canoes and kayaks not available during this time. Price: \$15/person

FLOSSENBUERG CONCENTRATION CAMP LIBERATION BIKE RIDE April 23

On April 23, 1945, the Flossenbuerg Concentration Camp was liberated by members of the 358th and 359th US Infantry Regiments (90th US Infantry). Join us 73 years later for a bike ride to the Flossenbuerg Concentration Camp Memorial Site and Museum. Upon completion of the ride and museum visit, riders will be transported back to Grafenwoehr via bus and bike trailer. The ride distance is approximately 55 kilometers. Riders should be in average/above average biking condition for this ride. Children are not permitted on this ride. Price: \$39/person (minimum of 8 people, maximum of 20)

KLETTERSTEIG

April 21 | July 21 | September 15

Looking for a new way to get vertical in your local area? The Klettersteig, or "Via Ferrata" in Italian, was originally used by the Italian military as a means of transporting troops and supplies through the Dolomites during WWII. The Klettersteig is similar to rock climbing because it uses much of the same safety equipment; however, rather than climbing up the rock face, climbers will traverse the face on an established route. Participants are attached by a self-belay system to a steel cable that runs the length of the route. No prior climbing experience necessary. Transportation, equipment and guide included. Price: \$35/person

Warrior Adventure Quest (WAQ) is a DA approved and endorsed program under Executive Orders for all units. WAQ is designed to recreate the adrenaline rush of combat action in a supervised, controlled, high-adventure activity, which is supervised by Family and MWR Outdoor Recreation.

WAQ instills cohesion, builds teamwork and maintains combat readiness through challenging activities. This program enables Soldiers to reach a "new stage of normal" by diminishing boredom and high-risk behavior through outdoor recreation and a Leader-Led After Action Debriefing (L-LAAD). Soldiers will be able to draw similarities between the adventure activity and their Warrior experiences. This portion will be conducted by unit leadership (Squad Leader, NCOIC, OIC, Commander, etc.).

WAQ is offered at no cost to units. Funding has been provided by the Department of the Army. All units are now eligible for participation. Non-deploying units can attend once every two years. Units who are 120 days prior to deployment or 120 days after deployment can attend during that time frame.

All WAQ activities take place during duty hours. Only available to Service Members.

WAQ is a Leader and Soldier Program designed to support the Ready/Train and RESET phases of the ARFORGEN process. The designated facilitator will need to meet with a WAQ representative prior to the event. WAQ representatives will teach the leaders how to properly conduct an L-LAAD.

The Hunting, Fishing and Sport Shooting program (HFSS) is a great resource for upcoming hunts. HFSS can find hunting opportunities in the local area with Federal, State Forestry and private hunters. The office assists with the submission for registering firearms and contact information for purchasing firearms from private citizens.

Hunting in Germany is steeped in customs and traditions and has often been exclusively for the upper class until the past 30 years or so. Gun ownership in Germany is a privilege, and there are strict guidelines that must be followed to own, store and fire a weapon. One way to possess a firearm is to pass an authorized hunting course that HFSS offers.


