5. ENTRIES:	Garrison's/Base's are authorized an unlimited number of competitor entries.
6. <u>ELIGIBILITY:</u>	a. This competition is only open to US Active Duty/Active Reserve Military members.

b. Service Members must be assigned or attached on official orders to the Garrison/Base they represent.

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7. **REGISTRATION:** Pre-re

8. TEAM ROSTERS:

Each Garrison/Base must submit a roster, complete with all the pertinent information (unit, name and rank) verified by the Garrison/Base Sports Director.

9. CATAGORIES:

- a. This competition will be limited to NOVICE and OPEN Boxers, based upon individual boxing records and weight divisions.
- b. Competition is open to both Male and Female Boxers.
- 10. WEIGHT CLASSES:
- a. MALE (10 Weight Classes): 106lbs, 112lbs, 119lbs, 125lbs, 132lbs, 139lbs, 147lbs, 156lbs, 165lbs, 176lbs, 189lbs, 203lbs, 203+lbs.

b. FEMALE (10 Weight Classes): 106lbs, 110lbs, 115lbs, 19lbs, 125lbs, 132lbs, 139lbs, 146lbs, 154lbs, 165lbs, 178lbs, 178+lbs.

11. **FORMAT:**

- a. Single Bouts
- b. Duration of Rounds:
- 1. NOVICE Female and Male Novice boxers will box three (3) 90 seconds rounds with a one-minute rest period between rounds.

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- 2. OPEN Female and Male Open Boxers will box three, two-minute rounds, with a one-minute rest period between rounds.
- c. Quotas will not be set on the number of entrants a Base/Garrison/Unit may submit; however, the final selection of who will be competing lies solely on the discretion of the Tournament Director(s) and the Rules of USA Boxing.
- d. Pairing requirements/factors:
- (1) Age (Boxers 35 years and older are entered into the Masters Division).
- (2) Record (11 bouts and greater, Boxer is considered to be OPEN), (10 Bouts and less, Boxer is considered to be NOVICE). Boxers will be paired accordingly).
- (3) Garrison/Base (If two individuals are paired from the same Garrison/Base, they will be briefed along with their coach for mutual agreements prior to the scheduling the bout)
- e. Boxers are authorized to have up to (2) two coaches in their respective corner.

12. WEIGH-INS / PHYSICALS:

- a. Weigh-ins and medical physicals will be conducted Saturday, 26 October 2024, at the Field House, B547, Tower Barracks, from 0700-0900 hours, day of competition. IAW USA Boxing / USAREUR Reg. 215-1 Weigh-ins and medical exams are mandatory and must be completed on site. Failure to complete weigh-ins and physicals will result in *NO COMPETITION*.
- b. USA Boxing Technical Rule 5.1.3.1. Boxers who wish to compete with braces are required to have a completed Release to Compete with Braces form. This form requires the written approval of their dentist and a dentist-molded mouthpiece.

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13. <u>COACHES/BOXERS</u> <u>BRIEFING:</u>

a. All boxers/coaches must be present for the Mandatory Administrative and Safety Briefing on Saturday, 26 October 2024, at 1330 hours, Field House, B547, Tower Barracks.

14. **EQUIPMENT:**

- a. Host site will provide USA Boxing certified safety equipment; gloves, groin protectors, breast protectors, head gear, hand wraps, etc.
- b. Glove Size- Each competitor will compete with 12 oz.

c. Mouthpiece

- 1. A mouthpiece must be worn for boxers to compete. Boxers are responsible for their own form fitted mouthpiece and we highly recommend that you visit your local dentist and get a molded form fitted mouthpiece.
- d. No **red**, shades of **red**, or partially **red**-colored mouthpieces may be worn.
- 3. Boxers who wish to compete with braces are required to complete a Release to Compete with Braces form. This form requires a written approval from the competitor's dentist and a dentist-molded mouthpiece. This includes upper and/or lower braces.

d. Competition Uniform

- 1. Host site will provide uniforms for Boxers to sign out, if required.
- 2. Boxers must wear a sleeveless athletic shirt (singlet or jersey), of a different color from the waistband of the trunks.
- 3. Boxers must wear a pair of loose-fitting trunks that reach halfway down the thigh, no lower than the knees. The trunks must provide a waistband of a different color than the athletic shirt.

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4. Boxers must box in lightweight boots or shoes (without spikes or heels), socks (not to be worn higher than knee length).

15. OFFICIALS:

The USAG Bavaria Sports Office will select qualified Referees/Judges/Jury/Timers, etc. to officiate this competition.

16. **MEDICAL SUPPORT:**

Host site is providing on site medical support to assist in physical exams to include the care, treatment, and evacuation of any injured/sick participants and/or spectators. Additionally, one medical doctor and two medics with an ambulance will be on site during the competition.
