1. <u>REFERENCES:</u>	a. AR 215-1, 24 Sep 10, Non-appropriated Fund Instrumentalities and Morale, Welfare and Recreation Activities.
	b. Army in Europe (AE) Regulation 215-1-8, 6 Jul 12, Conducting Europe Region Sports & League Championships.
	c. Current USA Boxing Official Rules.
2. <u>WHAT:</u>	United States Army Garrison Bavaria Boxing Clinic and Invitational Event.
3. <u>WHEN:</u>	Boxing Event – 16 March 2019, 1800 hours.
4. <u>WHERE:</u>	Memorial Fitness Center, Rose Barracks, Bldg. 616 USAG Bavaria, Vilseck.
5. <u>OPENING CEREMONY:</u>	Sat, 16 March 2019, 1745 hours, MFC, Bldg. 616. All boxers/coaches are required to participate in Opening Ceremonies.
6. ENTRIES:	Garrisons/Bases are authorized an unlimited number of entries.
7. <u>REGISTRATION</u> :	Pre-registration is required, Individuals and Teams must pre-register NLT 1 March 2019 by submitting their registration form to the following email; <u>usarmy.grafenwoehr.imcom-fmwrc.list.sports-and- fitness@mail.mil</u>

8. <u>CANCELLATION</u>	A minimum of twenty (20) Boxers is required for the event to be conducted. If twenty (20) Boxers are not pre- registered prior to 1 March 2019 the event will be cancelled.
9. <u>ELIGIBILITY:</u>	a. This competition is open to US Active Duty/Active Reserve Military members Only.
	b. Each military member must be assigned or attached on official orders to the Base/Garrison/Unit they represent.
10. <u>CATAGORIES:</u>	a. Competition will be limited to NOVICE and OPEN Boxers, based upon individual boxing records and weight divisions.
	b. Competition is open to both Male and Female Boxers.
11. WEIGHT DIVISIONS:	a. FEMALE: 106lbs, 112lbs, 119lbs, 125lbs, 132lbs, 141lbs, 152lbs, 165lbs, 178lbs, 178+lbs.
	b. MALE: 108lbs, 114lbs, 123lbs, 132lbs, 141lbs, 152lbs, 165lbs, 178lbs, 201lbs, 201+lbs.
12. <u>PHYSICALS/WEIGH-INS:</u>	a. Medical physicals and Weigh-ins will be conducted Sat, 16 March 2019, MFC, Bldg. 616, 0900-1200 day of the competition. Weigh-ins and medical exams are mandatory, and IAW with USA Boxing and USAREUR Reg. 215-1. Failure to complete weigh-ins and physicals will result in NO COMPETITION!
	b. USA Boxing Technical Rule 5.1.3.1. Boxers who wish to compete with braces are required to have a completed Release to Compete with Braces form. This form requires the written approval of their dentist, parents and/or guardian (if under 18 years of age) and a dentist-molded mouthpiece.
13. <u>COACHES/ BOXER</u> <u>MEETING</u>	All Coaches/Boxers must be present for the mandatory safety briefing on Sat, 16 March 2019, @ 1600 hours at

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safety briefing on Sat, 16 March 2019, @ 1600 hours at Memorial Fitness Center, Bldg. 616, Rose Barracks.

14. <u>FORMAT:</u>	 a. Duration of Rounds: 1. NOVICE – Female and Male Novice boxers will box three (3) – 90 seconds rounds with a one-minute rest period between rounds.
	2. OPEN - Female and Male Open Boxers will box three (3), two (2) minute rounds and with a one (1) minute rest period between rounds.
	b. Quotas will NOT be set on the number of entrants a Base/Garrison/Unit may submit; however, the final selection of who will be competing lies solely on the discretion of the Tournament Director(s) and the Rules of USA Boxing.
	c. Pairing requirements /factors:
	(1) Age (Boxers 35 years and older are entered into the Masters Division).
	(2) Record (11 bouts and greater, Boxer is considered to be Open, 10 bouts and less, Boxer is considered to be Novice). Boxers will be paired accordingly.
	d. Boxers are authorized to have two coaches in their respective corner.
15. <u>EQUIPMENT:</u>	a. The host site will provide certified equipment; gloves, groin protectors, breast protectors, head gear and hand wraps, etc.
	b. Mouthpiece - 1. A mouthpiece must be worn for boxers to compete.

Boxers are responsible for their form fitted mouthpiece and we highly recommend that you visit your local dentist and get a molded form fitted mouthpiece.

2. No red, shades of red, or partially red-colored mouthpieces may be worn.

3. Boxers who wish to compete with braces are required to complete a Release to Compete with Braces form. This

	form requires a written approval from the competitor dentist and a dentist-molded mouthpiece. This includes upper and/or lower braces.
	d. Competition Uniform – 1. Boxers must wear a sleeveless athletic shirt (singlet or jersey), of a different color from the waistband of the trunks.
	2. Boxers must wear a pair of loose-fitting trunks that reach halfway down the thigh, no lower than the knees. The trunks must provide a waistband of a different color than the athletic shirt.
	3. Boxers must box in lightweight boots or shoes (without spikes or heels), socks (not to be worn higher than knee length).
16. <u>AWARDS:</u>	a. First and second place individual awards for each bout. (Individual awards will be presented upon the conclusion of each bout on Sat, 16 March 2019.
	b. First, second and third place team awards. (Team awards will be presented at conclusion of the event).
	c. Best Overall Male & Female Boxer (Best overall award will be presented at conclusion of the event).
17. <u>TRANSPORTATION</u> :	It is the responsibility of each respective community of participants to provide transportation to and from this event.
18. <u>BILLETING:</u>	FREE Open Bay Troop Billeting is available for competitors only! Participants wishing to use this service must bring their own sleeping mats, sleeping bags, etc. This free service is on a first come, first serve basis.
