## Service Risk Categorization / Decision Authority

### Tier I: High Risk (USAREUR CG Decision)

Definition: Those with multiple elements we cannot control. Many include large groups, where safe physical distancing is not possible or we assess it would be very difficult to enforce distancing. This includes services where the maturity level of the group does not lend itself well to distancing. We also categorize services as high risk when they require person-to-person contact, for extended periods, where risk to transmission is far greater.

### Tier II: Medium Risk (SRO Decision—Inform USAREUR CG & IMCOM-E)

Definition: Those requiring closer personal interaction between service providers and customers, with additional mitigation measures: controlling access to services through appointments, providing services virtually where possible, service provider PPE (mission based).

### Tier III: Low Risk (Garrison Commander Decision ICW SRO—Inform USAREUR CG & IMCOM-E)

Definition: Those deemed essential to continue from the beginning of the outbreak, with mitigation measures: the ability to provide physical distancing between service providers and customers and amongst customers, sanitization, protective measures (plastic screens, hand wash stations) and protective equipment (face masks).
